



**CONNOQUENESSING BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING**

**July 2, 2019**

The public meeting of the Borough Council of Connoquenessing was called to order at 7:30 pm at the Connoquenessing Borough building.

Present were Council members Mary Grace Ruediger, Rob Campbell, Francis Smith, and Dave Hilliard.

Dan Cox, Emergency Management Coordinator, stated that the recently appointed Deputy EMA Coordinator, resigned due to personal issues. The Committee will continue efforts to fill the five deputy positions and will begin to work on the budget for the upcoming year.

The playground equipment will be ordered once a color is selected. Council discussed possibilities for addressing removal of the old equipment and site preparation.

Leslie Farms Phase 2 Update

The site contractor has been delayed in all projects due to rain and does not anticipate starting the Leslie Farms Phase 2 project until late fall or early winter, weather permitting.

Leslie Farms Phase 1 Update

A follow-up inspection was conducted by the Borough Engineer and a letter summarizing items needing addressed was sent to the developer.

Storm Sewer Structure Replacement Proposal

A proposal to repair a storm drain on Constitution Avenue was submitted by DemEx Demolition & Excavating for the amount of \$4,425. Ruediger motioned, Campbell seconded to obtain additional information for the repair. Motion passed.


