



## **CONNOQUENESSING BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING**

The public meeting of the Borough Council of Connoquenessing was called to order.

Dan Cox, CVREMA, reviewed details concerning the 15 KW generator. Aaron Miller provided details on obtaining two different quotes for installation. Discussion followed. Cox provided information on updating the emergency management plan following the updating of the Butler County plan.
