



**CONNOQUENESSING BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING**

**February 2, 2021**

The public meeting of the Borough Council of Connoquenessing was called to order at 7 pm using Webex, a remote access format.

Present were Council members Lloyd Leslie, Mary Grace Ruediger, Robert Campbell, Francis Smith, Dave Hilliard and Mayor Kate Stutz.

Also present were Thomas Thompson, Dave Bocci, Theresa Walko, and Vickie Forbes.

Theresa Walko, 159 Connoq Main Street, stated that she uses School Street to access her garage and that School Street is uneven, heaved, and rutted. Snow removal creates piles of debris on the sidewalk and along the street. Walko requested that the street be tar and chipped. Council discussed and stated the Street Committee would review in the spring.
