



CONNOQUENESSING BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING

July 7, 2026

The public meeting of the Borough Council of Connoquenessing was called to order.

Present were council members Chris Logan, David Smith, Lloyd Leslie, Ryan Curtin, and Mayor Williamson

Also present: Frank Stulgis, Dominic Oliver, Rob Campbell, Jacob Shalbot, Doug Oertel, Randy Anderson, Dave Bocci, Vickie Forbes, Angela Ferrari,

Frank Stulgis – Provided information to Council regarding Phase 1 stormwater pond.

Dave Smith advised HOA won't accept the retention pond until issues are resolved.

Randy Anderson – Asked if something will be done about speeding. Chris advised of the PennDOT study the Borough had done and shared with Mr. Anderson. Advised all options had been reviewed.

SEWAGE PLANT UPDATE

The Plant Operator gave the monthly update 25,000 average gallons weekly high. Dave advised to do begin examining a future expansion by 19,999 gallons to keep under major facility.

BUSINESS

Lloyd motioned, Ryan seconded, to approve June 2, 2026, meeting minutes with amendment. Motion passed

Ryan motioned, Lloyd seconded to approve the submitted May 2026 Treasurer's Report. Motion passed.

Dave motioned, Ryan seconded, to approve the submitted bills. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Harmony Street Adoption Ordinance 18-6 - Lloyd motioned for the Secretary to speak with solicitor to review consolidating all the amendments related to Harmony Street Adoption. Ryan seconded. Motion passed.

Hidden Springs Drive Adoption - Secretary advised list provided by the Engineer was completed. Ryan motioned to have the Solicitor develop ordinances to adopt Hidden springs in all facets with clarification and consolidation for related ordinances. Lloyd seconded. Motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Gannett Fleming – Road weight limits Feb 4, 2025 - Secretary advised the 2nd step was never taken to update the ordinance. Ryan motioned to approve weight limits for roads listed in the study (Lloydmont Boulevard, Leslie Farms Drive, Cameron Square Drive, Sutton Drive, Shelton Place Drive, Essex Court and Hawthorne Drive) added to the Ordinances with help from the Solicitor. Dave seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Leslie Farms Phases 4 & 5 - Developer requested a 60 day extension. Lloyd motioned, Ryan seconded approval, Dave nay' d for 60 day extension. Motion passed.

Ordinance 18-1 revisions - Lloyd motioned for Secretary to speak with the Solicitor to review consolidating all the amendments within Ordinance 18 and all dashed amendments following to consolidate. Ryan seconded. Motion passed.

Borough P.O. Box/Mailbox - Secretary shared mailer left in P.O. Box advising of the need to put in a mailbox at the park entrance or pay for the P.O. Box. Lloyd motioned and Dave seconded, keeping po box and Borough to pay fees. Motion passed.



COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Emergency Management: CVREMA meeting moved to July 20th

Fire: Fire department broke ground.

Law and Order: No Report

Streets: Discussed the potholes on constitution pricing etc. Lloyd motion. Ryan seconded to move forward with pothole repairs with Voelker with clarification that the section in the park is one of the 6 sections. Motion carried. Speed calming information report received discussed. Rob Campbell asked about Leslie Lane name change, he will review with EMS offices. Lloyd asked the Secretary to research road treatment 'fogging' and to ask Engineer regarding future paving.

Zoning/Planning: See Leslie Farms Phase 4 & 5, Douthett requested extension.

Borough Building: Secretary advised an emergency light in Borough Building had been repaired during yearly inspection.

Park: Park Committee chose RB Tree only to remove the large oak in the park due to safety concerns. Committee will have the oaks trimmed after a few frosts. Secretary shared Park Caretaker concern regarding residents not cleaning up after their dogs. Signs were posted by Secretary in post office, on website and Facebook page. Secretary requested to investigate trash cans/signs etc. situation get price on one, see the number the park would need.

Sewage Financial: No Report

Data center – Deborah sat in on a round table along with political representatives. Borough will review ordinances and options.

Resident advised that Gigliotti lowered the drain in phase 3 pond and Secretary will follow up with Borough Engineer.
